The City's Contractors, **All American Asphalt and City Light & Power**, are scheduled to begin construction on April 21, 2014, and the project is scheduled for completion, barring weather or other unforeseen delays, by April 2015. The work will take place along Pine Avenue between Anaheim Street and Seaside Way.

Segment 1 – Anaheim Street to 7th Street April 2014 – November 2014

- The project will involve landscape irrigation, landscape plantings and trees, street and pedestrian lighting, traffic signals, sidewalks, new intersection ramps, replacement of damaged sidewalks, curb and gutters, asphalt overlay and other related work.
- The contractor is scheduled to perform Segment 1 work **Monday thru Friday from 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM**. No parking signs will be posted 2 days prior to start of work. Block-by-block street closures are needed to complete work. Emergency vehicles, pedestrian, and delivery to businesses will be accommodated during closures.
