## Hellman Neighborhood Community Code Enforcement Program Block Captain Meeting

On Wednesday, October 26, 2011, the **North Alamitos Beach Association (NABA)** and the City of Long Beach South Division Code Enforcement staff held a monthly **Community Code Enforcement (CCE)** block captain meeting.

**Thirteen** Hellman neighborhood residents are working in collaboration with Code Enforcement inspectors to address property maintenance violations in the Hellman neighborhood. **Sixteen property maintenance violations** were filed on this day and a property maintenance update of past referrals was provided for all block captains. **City of Long Beach, Code Enforcement Inspector David Woods** addressed numerous questions regarding property maintenance and code violations. Since its reestablishment in 2009, the CCE program has helped to correct more than 1,000 property maintenance violations in the Hellman neighborhood. The next CCE meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, November 30, 2011, at the City of Long Beach Senior Center.

## Community Code Enforcement Meeting Willmore/Drake Park

On October 18, 2011, the Willmore City neighborhood's **Community Code Enforcement Group** held their monthly meeting. **Donald Olmstead, Code Enforcement Inspector**, welcomed everyone to the meeting at the new meeting space located at Drake Park at 951 Maine Avenue.

Approximately **15 residents** attended the meeting and had the opportunity to hear feedback from the previous months referrals.

The **Community Code Enforcement Group**, established in 2005, is composed of Willmore residents interested in helping Code Enforcement inspectors resolve issues within the community. Team leaders received training on how to identify code violations such as substandard buildings, property maintenance, inoperative vehicles, and weed abatement. These meetings give neighbors a platform to discuss and report code violations they observe in the **Willmore City** and **Drake Park Historic District**.
