The City's Contractors, *All American Asphalt and City Light & Power*, began construction on April 21, 2014, and the project is scheduled for completion, barring weather or other unforeseen delays, by July 2015. The work will take place along Pine Avenue between Anaheim Street and Seaside Way.

Segment 4 – Broadway to Ocean Blvd. September 2014 – April 2015

- To the maximum extend practical, inconveniences due to construction activities will be minimized. However, there will be temporary inconveniences including parking restrictions, street closures and noise.
- The project includes landscape irrigation, landscape plantings and trees, street and pedestrian lighting, traffic signals, sidewalks, new intersection ramps, replacement of damaged sidewalks, curb and gutters, asphalt overlay and other related work.
- The contractor is scheduled to perform most Segment 4 work Monday thru Friday from 11:00 PM to 11:00 AM. The noted Exceptions are Tree Trimming and Removal, including planter removals, will be done Sunday thru Thursday 9:30 PM thru 6:00 AM, and Paving work will be done Sunday thru Thursday from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM. Areas with Sidewalk Dining will be done Monday thru Friday from 11:00 PM to 8:00 AM, 6:00 AM to 11:00 AM and 1:30 PM to 4:30 PM. "No Parking" signs will be posted 2 days prior to the start of work. Block-by-block full and half street closures are needed to complete work. Emergency vehicles, pedestrians, and delivery to businesses will be accommodated during closures.
