The City’s Contractors, **All American Asphalt and City Light & Power**, began construction on April 21, 2014, and the project is scheduled for completion, barring weather or other unforeseen delays, by June 15, 2015. The work will take place along Pine Avenue between Anaheim Street and Seaside Way.

Segment 5 – Ocean Blvd. to Seaside Way April 24, 2015 – June 15, 2015

- The project will involve landscape irrigation, landscape plantings and trees, street and pedestrian lighting, traffic signals, sidewalks, new intersection ramps, replacement of damaged sidewalks, curb and gutters, asphalt overlay and other related work.
- The contractor is scheduled to perform most **Segment 5 work Monday thru Friday from 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM. The noted Exception is the Asphalt Paving, work will be done Sunday thru Thursday from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM.** “No Parking” signs will be posted 2 days prior to the start of work. Temporary street closures and Lane closures will be required to complete work. Emergency vehicles, pedestrians, and delivery to businesses will be accommodated during closures.
