SUMMARY OF WORKSHOP #3

The third community workshop for the Green TI Plan (also known as the Terminal Island Freeway Transition Plan) was held on Saturday, July 18th, 2015 at Silverado Park from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. 42 participants signed-in to the event. The workshop began with a brief presentation, showcasing the existing conditions of the Terminal Island Freeway, and described a variety of design alternatives for the project. These alternatives demonstrated options for the road location, level of road accessibility, division of planted buffer zone versus people space, spatial organization, and the site story. The presentation concluded with two conceptual designs of how the freeway may be converted in order to inspire and cultivate discussions with workshop participants.

After the presentation, participants were divided into small groups to discuss and comment on design alternatives for one of the two site stories. Afterwards, participants moved to another table to repeat the activity for the other site story. After learning about the two site stories and their design alternatives, participants were asked to fill out a scorecard to direct how the project should move forward.

This report summarizes the small group activities and presents the results from the scorecard responses. In total, 24 scorecards were collected that are referenced at the end of this document.

WORKSHOP 3 RESULTS PART 1

Participant Comments for “Road”



- The road should be on the west side with one lane for each direction
- West alignment may work if it were designed to accommodate more traffic
- Support for the road in the center to reduce impacts
- Support for the road on the east to serve adjacent schools and park
- Support for no change to the freeway
- Support access @ Hill, 20th, and Willow
- If there is a road, make it an interactive feature as people drive over it
- Support for north and south entrance and exit. Hill St. should remain closed to vehicular access, but open to emergency vehicles and pedestrians
- The road should be closed at night
- Support for emergency vehicles with entrance at Hill St only
- Road needs cuts, multiple access points, and more buffer and less urban parts
- Have dirt roads instead of cement roads
- Incorporate parking on either side of the road
- Support traffic calming
- Consider bicycle safety
- Open space should incorporate safe play areas for kids
- Entrances should be ADA accessible
- Incorporate activities for seniors
- Incorporate concerts in this park
- Support for lights/art for cultural events
- Support for more trees
- Build something that does not adds trips, trucks, or pollution
- Consider installing a monorail to improve traffic
- Consider making the road a drag strip
- Consider the benefits the community gets in terms of employment construction?


Participant Comments for the “Buffer”

- Build a sound wall between railroad and buffer; a concrete sound wall is preferred






