## CITY OF LONG BEACH REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NEIGHBORHOOD PARTNERS PROGRAM RFP-NPP-0922



The City of Long Beach, Department of Development Services, Housing and Neighborhood Services Bureau has issued a Request For Proposals (RFP) to solicit proposals from established Long Beach neighborhood and community groups to participate in the Neighborhood Partners Program. Qualified applicants will compete for matching grants of up to a \$10,000, for goods and services to support mini-infrastructure improvement projects that have a lasting public benefit in their neighborhoods. The disbursement of the grant funds will be provided directly to the vendors and service providers and paid by the City of Long Beach. Matching funds from selected groups may be in the form of cash, or goods and services, and volunteer work hours. Projects must be located within designated CDBG areas (see attached map).

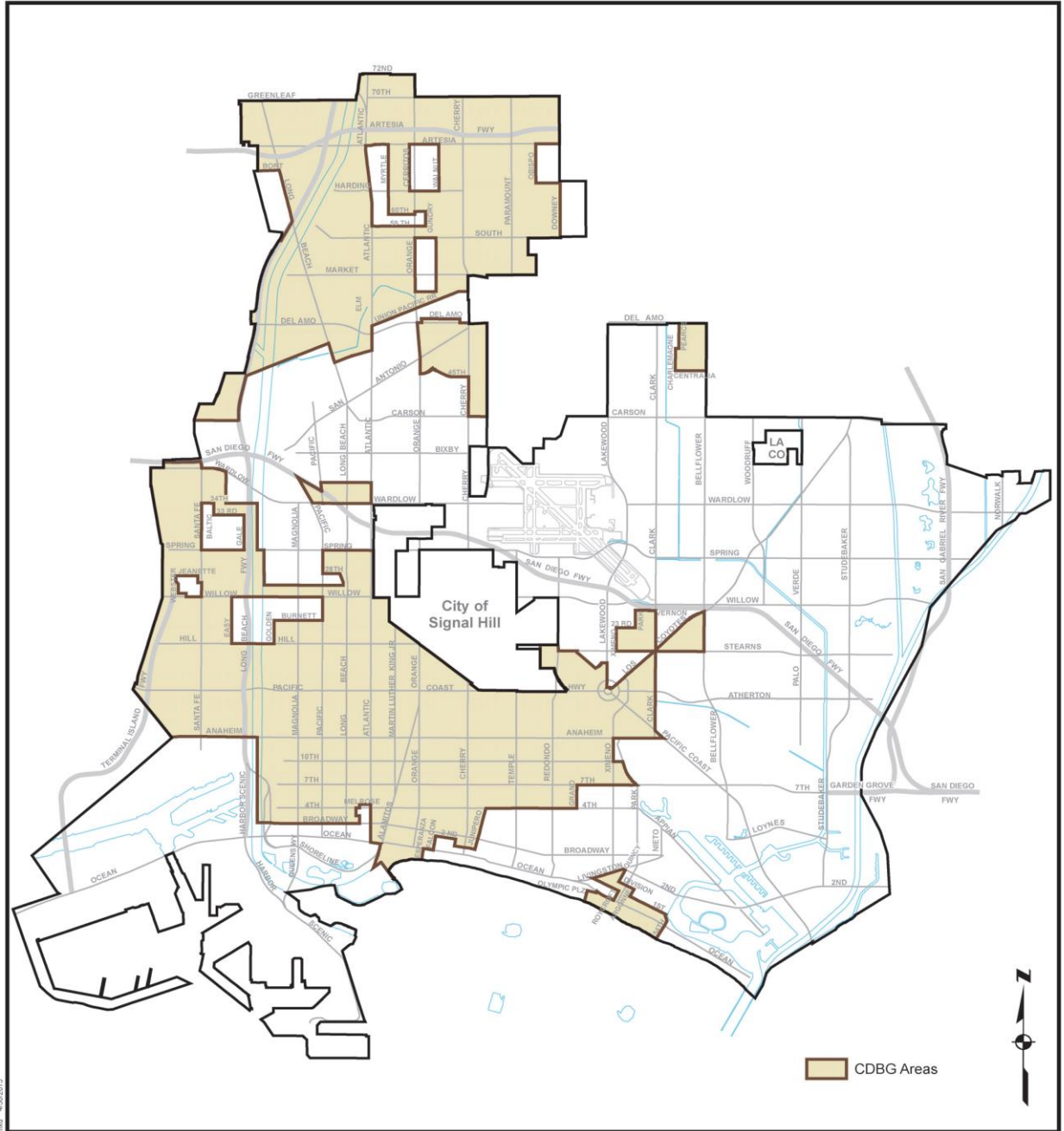
